

FNA CLUB BANNER POLICY

March 2021

A) INTENT OF THE POLICY

The policy is to ensure that Fremantle Netball Association (Inc) ('FNA') provides guidelines on when and where Clubs may display their club banners. For the purpose of this policy, banners include, but are not limited to: tear drop banners, posters, corflute and other signage that are fixed to the ground or another surface, either temporarily or permanently.

B) HOW THE POLICY WORKS

- 1. The policy refers to the use of Club banners and how they are displayed on the FNA grounds.
- 2. Clubs should refer to this policy when placing any banners at FNA.

C) THE POLICY

- 1. Clubs may not display banners during competition days in the winter season except during the Finals rounds.
- 2. During Final rounds, Clubs are permitted to display a maximum of two banners each.
- 3. When placing banners clubs should ensure that the placement of their banner is not obstructive to spectators or foot traffic and that the banner is secured safely.
- 4. Banners can be placed in the following areas:
 - i. the grass in front of the wall along High St at the southern end of courts 6, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23, 25, 27.
 - ii. the grass at the northern ends of Courts 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, 28.
 - iii. the paved areas at the northern end of courts 8, 10, 12, 14, 16.
 - iv. The grass alongside the fence by courts 4, 5 & 6
 - v. On the grass courts alongside courts 1, 2 & 3. No spiked banners to be placed here due to reticulation.
 - vi. The central grassed section between courts 15 & 17.
- 5. No banners to be placed within 3 metres of the court goal line or where they will impede the movement of an umpire. An umpire can request a banner to be moved in this instance.
- 6. No banner to be placed directly behind goalposts.
- 7. No banners or signs to be placed on any structure which is deemed for FNA use exclusively, e.g. the shed.
- 8. Clubs are expected to move banners where a reasonable request has been made.
- 9. Banners may be moved at any time by FNA if it is deemed necessary.
- 10. Banners that include sponsor names or logos will need to be approved by FNA prior to being displayed.

D) POINTS TO NOTE

- Clubs are responsible for collection & storage of their own banners.
- Banner placement is subject to approval by FNA Grounds Coordinator and Clubs may need to move their banner upon request.
