

In 2021, FNA opened a time capsule from the 2000 committee, revealing a series of logos used since its founding in 1960. This inspired the decision for a logo refresh, showcasing new designs created by the team.

The integration of Fremantle Sharks into the FNA community marked a significant step in ensuring the Pathway and Sharks are part of one unified community. FNA aims to support the development of players, umpires, coaches, volunteers, and all involved, from NetSetGo to WANL, while also fostering a welcoming environment for everyone.

The goal is to ensure that the FNA and Sharks communities are connected, with Sharks having a visible presence at FNA. It was another year of changes, which were so well received by the Community. Thank you to everyone involved in making FNA such an enjoyable place to spend so much of our time. Each and every person's contributions make a difference and it is appreciated by the FNA Committee and Staff.



New uniforms

With MG's sponsorship, we updated our uniforms across the board, including pathway dresses, hoodies, committee and umpire shirts, jackets, and the Fremantle Netball Association banner.

Competition structure change

While recognising the cultural value of the existing competition structure, external factors like school ages, schooling, and work choices, and low team entry numbers into the 19 & Under competition year on year made a compelling case for change.

The agreed changes were:

- Remove the 19 & Under competition.
- Realign the 17 & Under competition into an 18 & Under competition.
- Shift the premier junior competition from a 15 & Under competition to a 16 & Under competition.
- The Committee agreed to introduce a Perpetual Trophy and a Grand Final MVP medal for the 18U1 division.

Renaming of competition divisions

There was a strong attachment to the existing lettering system, especially among longstanding community members. However, clearer communication could be achieved with age group names.

The agreed changes were Open, 18 & Under, 16 & Under, 15 & Under, and so on.

Coffee on the go

New coffee machines were purchased for the cafe, kiosk, and canteen. To handle high demand for early morning coffee, Fruber coffee delivery was introduced for 50 cents, paid to enthusiastic delivery staff (junior players who wanted to help).



Rolling substitutions

Rolling substitutions were introduced and used across all Junior, 18 & Under, and Open divisions which turned out to be a very positive experience.

Recognition of service

Les Preedy, an FNA Life Member and Winthrop Club member, was recognised for his 27 years of commitment and service to netball becoming the 101st Life Membership of Netball WA during the Opening Ceremony of the Fuel To Go & Play Association Championships.



At the same event, Lisa Callaghan, Palmyra Rebels Netball Club President, was awarded the Netball WA Coaching Achievement Award. This was a fantastic recognition for Lisa and her ongoing pursuit of coaching excellence.



Fremantle Ports Support

The Umpiring Committee was once again successful in obtaining a \$5,000 grant from Fremantle Ports, which was used to fund the Umpiring Academy and other umpiring programs.

Boorloo NAIDOC Netball Carnival

FNA entered four teams to the carnival, with 27 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander athletes taking part, including 21 from FNA Clubs, plus nine non-Indigenous athletes. Each team won at least one game, and it was a successful event.

Teams were named Walyalup Marlee (Swans), Walyalup Kworbardak Yoks (Beautiful Girls), Walyalup Djindas (Stars), and Walyalup Djookan (Sisters). We were grateful to coaches Simone Bropho, Megan Hill, Deb Librizzi, Mandy Lansbury, and Bek Fielding. Special thanks to Simone Barnes for her significant contributions and Janelle Mudie for the supply of Fremantle Uniforms.



Parking Crossover Completion

The new exit to the oval car park was completed. Sincere thanks to FNA community member Alex Leijser for managing the project and BOS Civil for supplying equipment. Alex's dedication and hard work are greatly appreciated by the Association.

Education and Training

The Association hosted a Cultural Awareness Training session funded by the City of Fremantle under the Grassroots for Champions Every Club grants. This session, aimed at increasing awareness of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander history and culture, was run by a First Nations speaker.

The Association also hosted an online information session featuring Ava Oprandi from the Working with Children Screening Unit. Ava presented on Club obligations and procedures, followed by a Q&A session.

Tractor Farewell

Sadly, after many years of dedicated service, the FNA tractor stopped working which will be replaced in 2025.

WINTER COMPETITION

We had 463 teams nominate in 2024. The 2024 season saw some changes to our Winter Competition with the renaming of our Competition grades.

Senior A, Senior B and Senior C grades became Open Division 1 down to Open Division 17. We removed the 19U and 17U grades and introduced 18U and 16U grades, with the 16U grade now becoming the pinnacle of the Junior competition.

The 18U grade was made up of 38 teams and the 16U grade 30 teams. Junior grades went from 16U down to 11U (formerly Junior E). Go grades were renamed 10U Go and 9U Go and Set grade 8U Set.

We had 25 Clubs participate in our Winter Competition, of which 19 Clubs won at least one Premiership. Dalmatinac and St. Christopher's were the most successful Clubs, winning seven Premierships each. St. Christopher's won Open Division 1 Grand Final, Tingara won 18U Division 1 Grand Final, and Palmyra Rebels won 16U Division 1 Grand Final. Junior Umpire Development Program

In 2024, 42 beginner umpires participated in the Junior Umpire Development Program, from 100 registered to trial. The program was run by our two development program coordinators, Erica Miglori and Dana Gibaut. These 42 participants were representing by 15 Clubs. In 2024 we saw 24 C badges and four umpires elevated to our FNA Umpire Academy program.

This year's program saw participants move through the grades as their skill levels increased. Thank you to the coaches for their dedication to the program and contribution to the results achieved.

Adult Umpire Development Program

2024 was the third year running this program at FNA with participation and success. This year each Club was offered a free spot into the program, with six Clubs taking on this opportunity.
